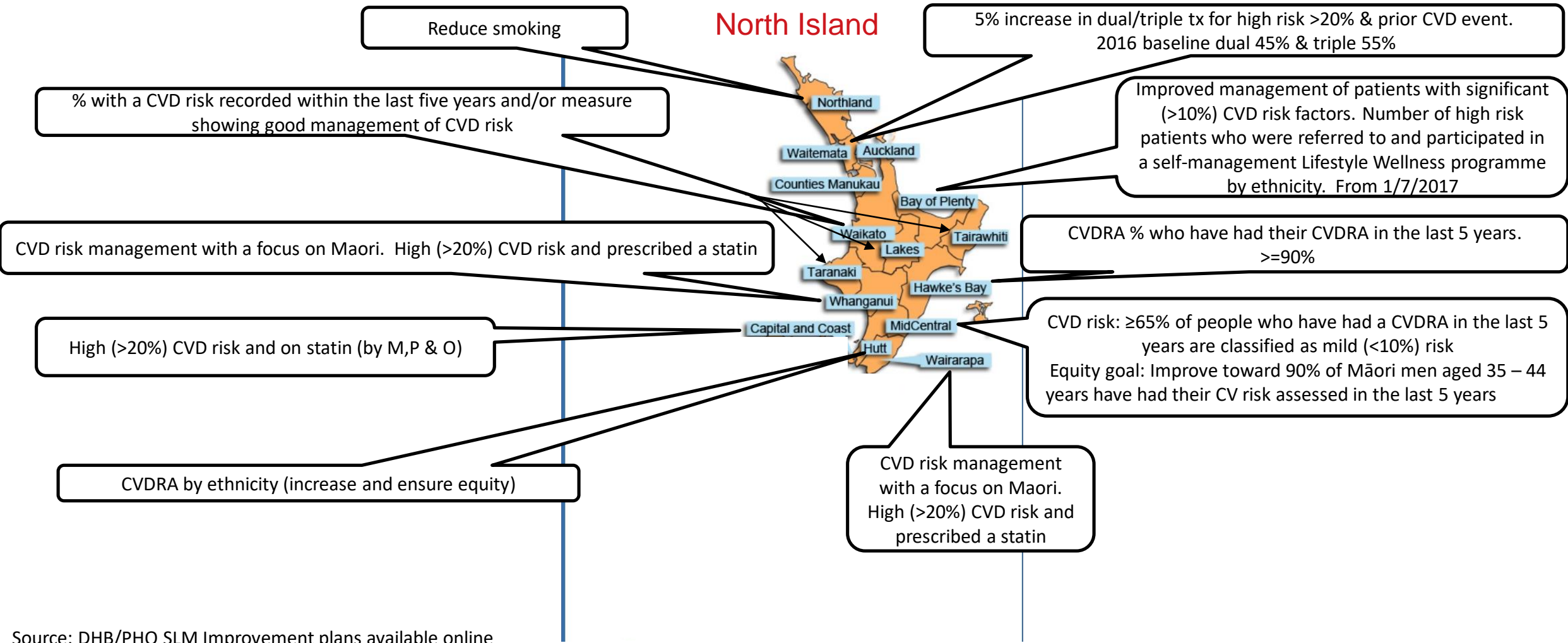

Maori Health Providers receive training and expert nurse support for diabetes and cardiac care from July 2016. health pathways developed for pre-diabetes focused on integrated care and an approach for Maori and groups with inequitable health outcomes by Dec 2016.

CVDRA % who have had their CVDRA in the last 5 years.
>=90%

CVDRA completed in the last five years. Target 90%.

90% CVD risk assessed in the last five years. 90% Māori men aged 35-44 years' CVD risk assessed in the last five years. Report on delivery of the actions and milestones identified in Annual plan.

- Increase adoption of positive lifestyle choices. Measured by referrals to specialist smoking cessation and Green Rx referrals
- Increase general practice skills in motivational conversations
